

Parish Welcomes Fr. Marcel July 2-3



Father Marcel Emeh was born and reared in his native country of Nigeria, the most populous nation in Africa. He is the third of six children of his father Marcel and his late mother Cordelia. Fr. Marcel's vocation began at a young age and was engendered by the witness of the deep faith of his parents. Nurtured by family prayer three times a day, regular attendance at daily Mass and Eucharistic Adoration, Fr. Marcel felt an early call to serve the Lord and his church.

Following elementary school, he applied for and was accepted for admission to a high school seminary in Nigeria where he met many other young, faithful men from across the country. He especially enjoyed its strong community life, which included daily prayer, study, shared meals, sports and many group activities. Once graduated, his attraction to communal living prompted a desire to join the Claretian Missionaries. However, after completing his philosophical studies he decided to take a leave of absence to better discern his future vocation in life. During these sabbatical years he took advantage of an opportunity to work in Rome, which provided the chance to work in a large hotel, enjoy a comfortable life and all the benefits it provided, including travel in Europe and abroad. As the years past, however, he once again found himself yearning for a deeper calling and purpose by serving our Lord as a priest. Having recently learned about the Salvatorians (the Society of the Divine Savior), he was attracted by their charism and Universality of their mission.

He was accepted by the Salvatorian province in the United States and resumed his studies by attending Sacred Heart School of Theology in Wisconsin. He was ordained a priest in June 2018 and has enjoyed serving the past four years as the parochial vicar of Divine Savior Parish in Orangevale. Fr. Marcel is now excited to begin his second assignment at Holy Trinity Parish beginning July 1. In his free time, he enjoys fitness, hiking and going to the movies. He looks forward to meeting and getting to know the community of Holy Trinity Parish.

Mother Teresa Maternity Home Board Members Needed



Questions for Faith Sharing July 10 Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In next week's Gospel, Luke 10:25-37, when the so called "scholar of the law" asks Jesus about inheriting eternal life, Jesus questions him about what is written in the law. Knowing the "right answer" does not equate with understanding the Scriptures. In response to the scholar's question, "And who is my neighbor?", Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan, a story that exemplifies the selfless love of a true neighbor.

• When have you put yourself at risk to help someone as does the Good Samaritan? If there were repercussions, were you still glad that you showed mercy?




