

- Prepare the roster of linen ministers, with phone number and email address by the beginning of each year.
- Assign 1 minister per month to launder the linens.
- Share the roster with the parish office and other linen ministers.
- Each month, email the linen minister responsible for the month to remind them of start and finish days. Share with them of any difference or changes - if there is a funeral, Holy Day of Obligation etc. Thank the minister who did the previous month.
- Recruit and train new ministers.
