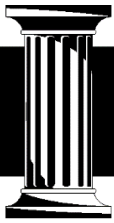
This annual event is held around the country among countless numbers of parishes throughout the United States. We ask for your continued prayers for an end to abortion and for God's continued blessing on our country.

Questions for Faith Sharing Nov. 12 Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

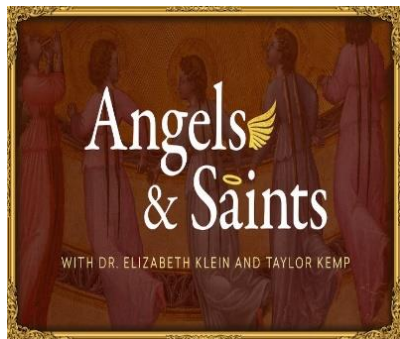
In next Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 25:1-3, the emphasis is on waiting and watching. To know neither the day nor the hour, but to nonetheless remain prepared, is to live in hope. Matthew knew that such faith-filled waiting required self-control and prudence. The lesson for Christians, then, is to treat every moment as if it might be the moment of Christ's return.

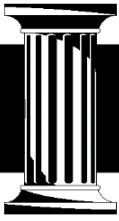

ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Because of your commitment to the *One Parish Family* Capital Campaign, Holy Trinity's financial position has improved dramatically. Parishioners pledged \$2.8 million - 93% of our \$3.0 million goal to address parish debt and financial obligations and critical repairs and maintenance to our facilities.

- Received \$2.74 million of the \$2.8 million pledges, allowing us to
 - o Repair the roofs on the Social and Education Centers
 - o Repairs to the church bell Tower and narthex
 - o Repairs the south side of the Church (baptistry, quieting room, and view room)
