### A Note of Gratitude (and Appeal) from Father Larry

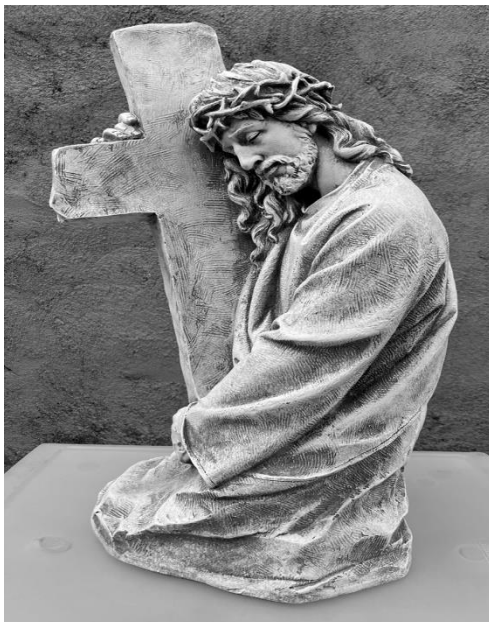

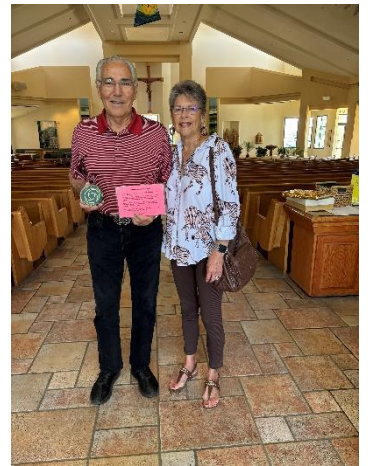


### Gift Bearers

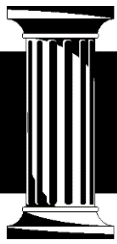

### The RCIA has a new name!

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has approved a new translation of the name of the process of becoming Catholic, now calling it **OCIA**, the "Order of Christian Initiation of Adults."

Rites are still part of the Order, but the new structure is meant to invite candidates and catechumens into a continuous process of spiritual formation and an ongoing journey of lifelong discipleship.

## Questions for Faith Sharing Jul. 28 Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In next Sunday's Gospel, John 6:1-15, we hear John's rich Passover imagery recalling the gift of manna, which situates Jesus in the tradition of Moses and affirms God's gift of freedom. The abundance of loaves and fish evokes a liberative banquet of images. Jesus communicates how he embodies God's power and presence, inviting everyone to this new relationship.

### Reflection for families:

- Jesus' action reflects Elisha's prophetic activity. Why might John present Jesus in line with God's prophets?

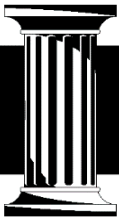

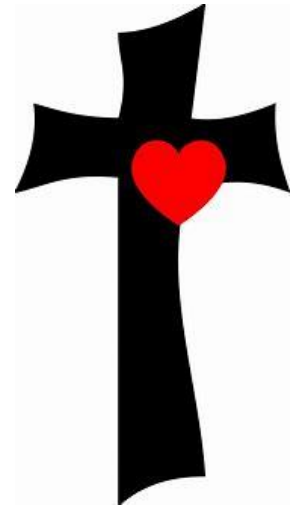
