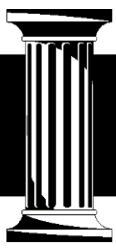

Questions for Faith Sharing Jun. 23 Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In next Sunday's Gospel, Mark 4:35-41, we hear the narrative of Jesus controlling the stormy waters which is replete with scriptural symbolism and interpretive force. This force reveals the power and presence of God. As calm overtakes the waters, he challenges his disciples' faith and they recognize the theophany, which is the manifestation of God in the lives of people from creation throughout history.

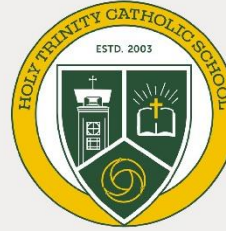

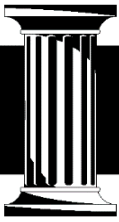

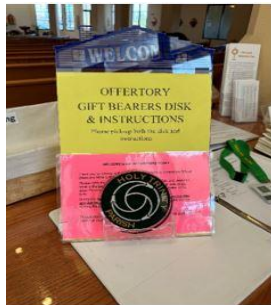
