

April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month. It is most appropriate that Child Abuse Prevention Month is held during the Easter season. There is no better time than Easter to celebrate the protection of our most valuable gift from God - our children.

*Week 5 - Did you know.....*What is happening in the diocese to protect children?

- Training is provided for all adults and youth to identify warning signs and develop strategies for maintaining a safe environment for all.
- A designated Victim Assistance Coordinator is available to receive reports and accompany victims through their journey.
- A volunteer independent Review Board assists the bishop in the review of cases and makes recommendations for moving forward.
- A Safe Environment Coordinator assists parish and school personnel with training and background screenings for anyone who may have access to children.
- An audit is conducted by an independent firm to evaluate implementation of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. Findings are incorporated with those of other dioceses and made available in an Annual Report.

Campus Grounds Update

This past week conduit was installed under the driveways and in three sections of the trench. The remaining installation of pedestrian fencing and pedestrian gates at the eastside of the Education Center has been scheduled for Saturdays only. Vehicle gates and pedestrian gates are expected to be installed in May. The driveway areas that were cut for trenching will be re-paved in the coming weeks. Conduit for low voltage, high voltage, and water is being installed at each vehicle gate, location of future monument sign, and at the center island at our main entrance. We have designed a plan for at least one camera at each gate. We anticipate these projects will continue through May and possibly into June. Please pardon the dust as we work to improve our campus.
