# Stewardship...

This weekly series focuses on how our Sunday readings help us embrace a life of stewardship so that we may strengthen our relationship with God by sharing the blessings he has entrusted to us.



Today's First Reading from the First Book of Kings and Mark's Gospel passage center on the actions of two seemingly poor and helpless widows who show themselves to be faith-filled and generous stewards. In the eyes of the world, particularly in biblical times when there was no life insurance or Social Security, these widows were weak and completely dependent on others to take care of them. Each one found themselves in a desperate situation — one during a famine with a child to care for, and the other clearly impoverished with no source of help. Yet, each demonstrated both strength and generosity that distinguished them from those around them. Where did they get this strength of character?

It came from knowing who they are, and Whose they are. These women must have known their security would not come from their government (occupying Romans), or from family, or from connections with someone with a hidden storehouse of flour and oil. They were abandoned by society, but not by their God and Father.

Their security came from knowing they were daughters of the Most High God and from putting their faith in Him. They had no need to panic in the midst of natural disaster or to cling desperately to their menial resources. Their faith in God set them free to trust Him when all seemed hopeless. Their faith kept them detached from material possessions. Their faith allowed them to be brave and generous, to think of others' needs despite their own trials.

These women saw themselves as stewards, not owners, of the resources God had given them, regardless of how much or how little they had. And acting as stewards made them gracious, generous and mighty. They willingly returned to God the blessings he had entrusted to them, even as poor as they seemed to be to others.

# Thoughts to reflect on:

Think about what you just read in the last paragraph – "These women saw themselves as stewards, not owners, of the resources that God had given them..." How often do we hear someone, maybe even us, say "I have worked for everything I have. It's my hard work that made me successful. Let others work for their success?" Oh really? Yes, you worked hard, but who gave you the talent and the ability to develop the skills that enabled you to be successful? Your success isn't the result of the "Big Bang theory".

Your talent came from God as a free gift, no strings attached. You used the talent, and thankfully were successful, but it started as a gift (or more correctly, a blessing) from God to you. Now, like the poor widows in today's readings, you (all of us) are asked to share those gifts with others who are in need, just as God shared the resources you needed to help you be successful. That's what we are asked to do as "stewards" of the blessings God entrusted to us.
