
Fr. Avella's New Book



Eucharistic Miracle in Connecticut

"Very powerful, very awesome, very real, very shocking. But also, it happens, and today it happened." These were the words of Father Joseph Crowley (pictured below), the pastor of St. Thomas Catholic Church in Thomaston, Connecticut. He made this statement after the entire congregation witnessed what may have been a Eucharistic miracle on Sunday March 5th of this year, only about five months ago.

On that Sunday, while the liturgy of the Eucharist was celebrated, one of the Eucharistic ministers was running out of consecrated hosts in the Paten (the golden plate the host is held in). As each person came and received the Body of Christ, the number of remaining hosts was reduced. At one moment the paten was almost bare, but upon re-examination, the number of Eucharistic hosts had multiplied in the paten, and there was enough for all the believers who approached.



"They were running out of hosts and suddenly more hosts were there. So today not only did we have the miracle of the Eucharist, we also had a bigger miracle," the emotionally shocked priest commented during the Concluding Rites. Crowley's comment reminds us of the miracle of the true presence of Christ's body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist, and what a gift it is to have the opportunity to receive it. This Eucharistic miracle is currently under investigation by the Archdiocese of Hartford.

LET US PRAY: Jesus Christ, You died so we could live with You in Heaven yet You are present with us now in the form of the Eucharist. Thank you for Your sacrifice, for rising and for living on with us. Amen
