Holy Trinity Men's Ministry



Questions for Faith Sharing Jun. 30 Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In next Sunday's Gospel, Mark 5:21-43, Jesus gives Jairus, and us, some seemingly simple advice "Do not be afraid; just have faith". Though we are made in the image of God's nature, death entered the world, and we experience it in our sinfulness. When we are afflicted, it can be easy to be like those weeping and mourning the death of Jairus' daughter and ridicule Jesus as he calls us to not be afraid. However, we must cultivate a prayer life that strengthens us to believe that Christ will meet us as we experience hardships and afflictions.
