## Adoration

Spend time in prayer at Eucharistic Adoration on Thursdays from 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

## Albs Ministry

Laundering the albs (the white cloaks worn for church services) and return them at the end of the month.

## Altar Servers

Serve with the priests and deacons during the Sacred Liturgy and learn more about the Mass.

## Baking and Culinary

Support a variety of events through food preparation.

## Banking Ministry

Sort, count, and deposit financial gifts received at weekend Masses and special collections.

## Bereavement Ministry

Companion individuals and families who have suffered the loss of a loved one.

## Children's Liturgy of the Word

Teach weekly readings to children during the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Sunday Masses.

## Church Cleaning

Provide the services required to maintain church cleanliness.

## Community Servants

Help neighbors in need with small home projects and help maintain our campus grounds.

## Companion Prayer

Join other parishioners in weekly prayer.

## Divine Mercy

Join others in prayer and promoting the message of Divine Mercy.

## Doughnut Ministry

Serve doughnuts and refreshments after Sunday Masses.

## Eucharistic Ministers

Assist in the distribution of Holy Communion at Mass.

## Events Ministry

Promote parish community by planning and hosting social events.

## Faith Formation Ministry

Inspire others by sharing the treasures of our Catholic faith through discussion, study, and prayer as a catechist or assistant.

## Funeral Liturgy Ministry

Assist at funerals and memorial services.

## Funeral Reception Ministry

Assist families with arrangements for funeral receptions.

## Greeters

Welcome parishioners as they enter the church for Mass, assist with collections, and distribute music books/bulletins.

## Health Education

Provide awareness of how to maintain and improve physical and emotional well-being.

## Homebound Ministry

Bring Holy Communion to and pray with homebound parishioners.

## Infant Baptism

Assist our priests and deacons with preparing families for their child's baptism.

## Knights of Columbus

Join other service-minded men who help provide for our parish.

## Linen Ministry

Launder Altar linens used during sacred liturgy, as well as other parish linens.

## Liturgical Environment

Create a beautiful worship environment in the church for each liturgical season.
