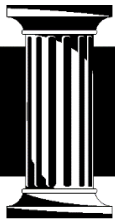

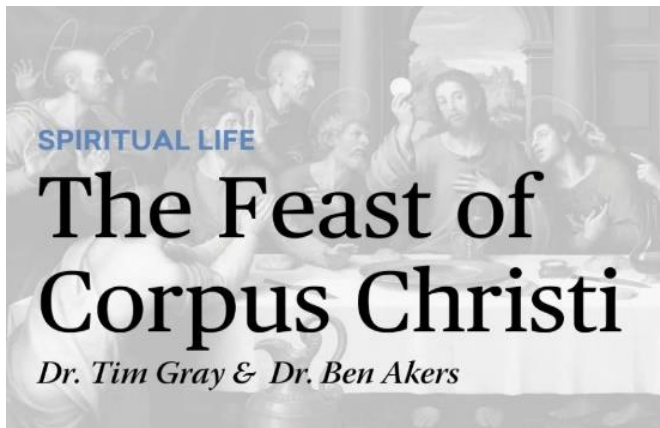
## Questions for Faith Sharing August 6

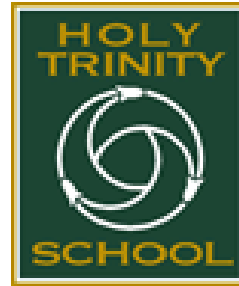
