


Learn to Pray the Liturgy of the Hours....No matter how busy your day may be!





- Each month, email the linen minister responsible for the month to remind them of start and finish days. Share with them any differences or changes - if there is a funeral, Holy Day of Obligation etc. Thank the minister who did the previous month.
