



### Annual Catholic Appeal





### Questions for Faith Sharing March 6, First Sunday of Lent

In next week's Gospel, Luke 4:1-13, Jesus provides a model of steadfastly turning away from temptation. We can feel driven to pursue careers, achievements and material things that steer our aim from God. Luke's Gospel shows the devil tempting and harassing Jesus in a number of ways. Jesus' response is simple and focused on God. It is easy to fall for temptations when feeling depressed, hungry, tired, or sick. Even though Jesus was famished, thirsty, weak, and lonely, he focused on his Father.

#### Reflection for families:

- How might temptation solidify a person's character?



### Pick of the Week:

*Into His Likeness* (Six 30-minute sessions)

Do you have a longing to follow Jesus more closely, to be transformed by him? It is God who has put that yearning in your soul and has given you the heart of a disciple.

Into His Likeness aims to help you follow those initial promptings of the Holy Spirit so that you may more intentionally encounter Jesus anew each day and be more disposed to the power of his grace molding you, transforming you ever more into his likeness.



## Diocese of Sacramento Lenten Regulations

Our Lenten journey of further conversion begins on **Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022**. Lent prepares the faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery of Christ's suffering, death and resurrection. It is a time for reflection and spiritual renewal, a time to examine one's relationships with God and with others. The Church also calls Catholics to a spirit of penance, above all with fasting, prayer and almsgiving, "which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, and to others." (Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC), nos.1969 and 1434).

**I. FAST AND ABSTINENCE**. To foster the spirit of penance and of reparation for sin, to encourage self-denial, and to guide us in the footsteps of Jesus, Church law requires the observance of fast and abstinence (CCC, nos. 1249-1253).

**1. Abstinence:** All persons who have already celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

**2. Fasting:** Everyone, from the celebration of their 18th birthday to their 59th birthday, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Voluntary fasting on other weekdays of Lent, especially on Wednesdays and Fridays, is highly recommended.

**II. PRAYER**. In order to deepen one's love for Christ, Catholics are urged to read scripture, pray more frequently, and to participate in devotions offered by the parish.

**1. Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation:** Lent is a privileged time for celebrating this sacrament. Parishes generally make readily available the Sacrament of Penance, including its communal celebration. People should attend also to reconciliation in every aspect of human life - personal, familial, societal, and ecclesial. At Holy Trinity, the Lenten Communal Penance service will be 7:00 PM, Tuesday, April 5, 2022. (During the Lenten and Easter time, Catholics are reminded that they are obliged to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance at least once a year.)

**2. The Stations of the Cross** are celebrated publicly in each parish on Fridays during the Lenten season. Parishioners are urged to participate. At Holy Trinity Stations will be at 6:00 PM on all Fridays during Lent beginning March 4, 2022.

**3. Easter Duty:** All Catholics who have been initiated into the Holy Eucharist are bound to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter Season. All Catholics are encouraged to receive Communion as often as possible, not only during Eastertide, but throughout the liturgical year.

**III. ALMSGIVING**. The act of giving to the poor, in the most ancient tradition of the Church, is an expression of penance, a form of piety, a witness of fraternal charity and an expression of Lenten conversion. Therefore, all Catholics are urged to support generously the charitable works of the Church through the Holy Trinity Stewardship program and other opportunities to help those in need. Parishioners are also encouraged to assist the sick, the aged, the needy and the imprisoned in other ways. Fasting and abstinence together with works of charity help Catholics live in solidarity with the crucified Christ reflected in the image of our brothers and sisters who suffer.
