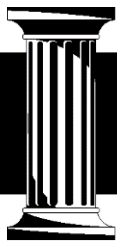

We Could Use Some Help at Funeral Masses

Usually with a team of two ministers, the tasks of the Funeral Liturgy Committee include setting up for the Funeral Mass (generally at 11:00 AM), assisting the family with flowers, orienting them to the Mass readings and the sequencing of the Mass, if they are unfamiliar, and greeting the family and guests as they arrive for Mass. We also may assist during Mass by serving at the Altar, proclaiming the Word and assisting the family with the gifts. This is such an important ministry to aid the family during their time of loss. The commitment is not too taxing, as we have between one and four Funeral Masses per month. It varies quite a bit. June 8, 2025: Pentecost Sunday - We will be commissioning/recommissioning our Liturgical Ministers at Masses throughout the Pentecost weekend. June 15, 2025: The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity - To celebrate our Parish Feast Day, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Adoration at the conclusion of the 11:00 AM Mass until just before the beginning of the 5:00 PM Mass.

June 22, 2025: The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) - This Feast Day ends the three-year Eucharistic Revival in the United States. We will have a Eucharistic Procession following the 11:00 AM Mass. All parishioners are invited to walk with our Eucharistic Lord around our Parish Campus.

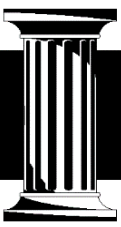

Questions for Faith Sharing June 8

Pentecost Sunday

In next Sunday's Gospel, John 14:15-16, 23b-26, we hear of the promise of the Spirit. Jesus reassures his followers that they will not be left alone after his death, resurrection, and ascension into heaven. Jesus tells them he will ask the Father to send them an Advocate: the Holy Spirit. As their Advocate, the Spirit will remind the disciples of Jesus' teachings. An advocate is also a helper, a defender, and an intercessor. Through the Spirit's presence, the disciples will be protected and empowered as they continue Jesus' work.

Seventh Sunday of Easter



Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

[ACTS 1:1-11](#); [PS 47:2-3, 6-9](#); [EPH 1:17-23](#); [10:19-23](#); [LK 24: 46-53](#)

On this Feast of the Ascension, we celebrate Christ's triumphant return to the Father after perfectly accomplishing His mission on earth. But we also can also view this Feast as a celebration of the "launch day" of our commissioning as Christ's disciples. In Paul's Letter to the church in Ephesus, we hear words that apply to us, as well. Paul writes, "May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in the knowledge of him." Open your heart and ears to the Holy Spirit's words leading us to a stronger relationship with God.

Today's Gospel draws our attention to the clear instructions that Jesus gave His disciples (and to us) just before ascending to the Father: "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things." Have you ever thought that we are "witnesses to these things" too? Every time we participate in Mass, we hear the Good News of scripture, and we witness the Holy Spirit coming down to change our gifts of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ Jesus.

Embracing a stewardship way of life, with its emphasis on the use of time, talent and treasure, helps us to live in such a way that our very lives speak as a witness of the Good News of the Gospel. While we take time to reflect and renew our commitments in these three areas annually as a parish family, it is of great benefit to take some time individually throughout the year to take stock of the commitments we have made — looking at both our strengths and our need for continued growth in each area.

On this Feast of our "launch day," take some time to celebrate your victories as Christ's disciples and renew your commitment to remain faithful to Him and the unique mission He has entrusted to you!
