Questions for Faith Sharing June 8 Pentecost Sunday

Jesus tells them he will ask the Father to send them an Advocate: the Holy Spirit. As their Advocate, the Spirit will remind the disciples of Jesus' teachings. An advocate is also a helper, a defender, and an intercessor. Through the Spirit's presence, the disciples will be protected and empowered as they continue Jesus' work.

Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

ACTS 1:1-11; PS 47:2-3, 6-9; EPH 1:17-23; 10;19-23; LK 24: 46-53

On this Feast of the Ascension, we celebrate Christ's triumphant return to the Father after perfectly accomplishing His mission on earth. But we also can also view this Feast as a celebration of the "launch day" of our commissioning as Christ's disciples. In Paul's Letter to the church in Ephesus, we hear words that apply to us, as well. Paul writes, "May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in the knowledge of him." Open your heart and ears to the Holt Spirit's words leading us to a stronger relationship with God.

Today's Gospel draws our attention to the clear instructions that Jesus gave His disciples (and to us) just before ascending to the Father: "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things." Have you ever thought that we are "witnesses to these things" too? Every time we participate in Mass, we hear the Good News of scripture, and we witness the Holy Spirit coming down to change our gifts of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ Jesus.

Embracing a stewardship way of life, with its emphasis on the use of time, talent and treasure, helps us to live in such a way that our very lives speak as a witness of the Good News of the Gospel. While we take time to reflect and renew our commitments in these three areas annually as a parish family, it is of great benefit to take some time individually throughout the year to take stock of the commitments we have made - looking at both our strengths and our need for continued growth in each area.

On this Feast of our "launch day," take some time to celebrate your victories as Christ's disciples and renew your commitment to remain faithful to Him and the unique mission He has entrusted to you!


