# **Blessing of Candles**

Thursday, Thursday, February 2 is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This Feast celebrates the day when Mary and Joseph presented Jesus at the Temple to consecrate him to the Lord. It is also known as *Candlemas Day*, traditionally a day when the Church blesses the candles that will be used during the coming year. This tradition of blessing candles comes from Luke's gospel when Simeon recognized Jesus as the Messiah and declared him "a light for the revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."(Lk 2:32) At the 8:15 AM Mass on February 2, Holy Trinity will bless the candles to be used in the Church throughout the year and we will bless candles brought by parishioners for use with their prayers and religious devotions in their homes.

# Questions for Faith Sharing Jan. 29 Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In next Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 5:1-12a, we hear the well-known Beatitudes. The blessed ones long for God's justice by securing justice for the oppressed. To them, God promises what their heart most desires; they will be satisfied with God himself; they will be "filled with all the fullness of God." The blessed ones sow shalom, peace, wherever they go. Because they are meek, they do not return evil for evil. Like Jesus, they are gentle. They reconcile enemies to God and to one another. They are called the children of God because they are like their Father.




