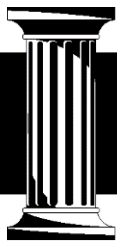

We Could Use Some Help at Funeral Masses

Usually with a team of two ministers, the tasks of the Funeral Liturgy Committee include setting up for the Funeral Mass (generally at 11:00 AM), assisting the family with flowers, orienting them to the Mass readings and the sequencing of the Mass, if they are unfamiliar, and greeting the family and guests as they arrive for Mass. We also may assist during Mass by serving at the Altar, proclaiming the Word and assisting the family with the gifts. This is such an important ministry to aid the family during their time of loss. The commitment is not too taxing, as we have between one and four Funeral Masses per month. It varies quite a bit. 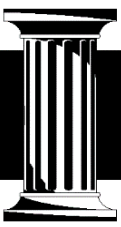

Pentecost Sunday

[ACTS 1:1-11; PS 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 COR 12:3B-7, 12-13; JN 20:19-23](#)



Today we reach the finale of the Easter season with the celebration of the great Feast of Pentecost. Reflecting on today's readings, inspires a sense of awe as we consider the mighty power of the Holy Spirit at work giving birth to and sustaining our Church. Just as awesome — the same Spirit is calling to us this day to take up our part in the Church's saving work.

In the first reading, from Acts, we see the creative genius of the Holy Spirit moving through the newly confirmed Apostles “who began to speak in different tongues as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.” The large crowd, gathered from all over the world were “amazed” and “astounded” that each one could understand the Apostles speaking in their own language.

Each one of us, young and old alike, is personally called today by the Holy Spirit into the same mission as that of the first Apostles — to advance the Kingdom of God in our corner of the world. Just as He did on that Pentecost day, the Holy Spirit speaks to us in our “own language” to give us the Good News of the Gospel and urge us to share it. We can think of our own language as the particular gifts, talents, and passions we possess. We experience the presence of the Holy Spirit through them, and we are meant put them to the work in grateful service of the Kingdom of God. We do that by serving and loving our neighbors, and by our example as Christian stewards.

When we consider the stewardship way of life we are called to live, we often focus on the challenges it poses. Surrendering ourselves to God is indeed a challenging way to live. But it leads to a life that can be exciting, creative, and deeply rewarding. Stewardship allows us to experience life as a great adventure because it is a life guided and directed by the very source of power and creativity—the Holy Spirit!

Some thoughts from Deacon Jim:

One way to think about Pentecost is as the birthday of the Church. Easter was Jesus' resurrection that brought us the gift of our salvation, but since his resurrection, it was mostly his disciples to whom he appeared and spoke to. On Pentecost, those disciples received the power of the Holy Spirit to open wide the doors of the Good News to the world, and the great journey began! In our Baptism we receive the gift of wisdom from the Holy Spirit. We are called to speak out as the disciples did in our own “language” as examples to our community by how we live our life.
