Offertory Gift Bearers

We will be implementing a new process so that all parishioners will have the opportunity to offer the gifts of Bread & Wine to the presider. We suggest they sit

close to the back. During the collection, the holder of the disk will come to the back, return the disk to the lead greeter and they will be guided on how to bring the Offertory gifts to the priest.


