Questions for Faith Sharing Jan. 15 Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

In next Sunday's Gospel, John 1:29-34, John the Baptist bears witness to these two dimensions of God's salvation. The Baptizer declares that he came to make Jesus known to Israel (John 1:31), but he also recognizes that Jesus is the final Passover Lamb who will take away the sin of the world (John 1:20). Just as John the Baptist was sent to proclaim the word of God, each of us is also called to proclaim the good news.

 What does it mean that Jesus baptizes "with the Holy Spirit" (John 1:33)?




