Lord, teach me to pray. Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

GN 18:20-32; PS138:1-3, 6-8; COL 2:12-14; LK 11:1-13



In our Gospel reading from Luke, some disciples ask our Lord to teach them

how to pray. Jesus offers them the beautiful prayer which we, of course, call the Lord's Prayer, or the Our Father.

The Our Father is truly a steward's prayer. In it, we call upon God in an intimate way, as our Father. We ask that His will be done (not ours!) and that His kingdom come (not ours!). In other words, we remember that He is our Creator, everything is His, and our focus in life should be on His priorities, not our own. Then we ask Him to supply our needs (to give us our daily bread), to forgive our sins (as we forgive others), and to protect us from evil. That is, we proclaim our complete trust and faith in His care for us and His mercy towards us. We, too, commit to extending mercy ourselves as we forgive those who hurt us in some way.

As we pray the words of the Our Father, we recognize this basic truth about ourselves and God: God is our Father, and we are beloved and infinitely blessed to be His children. He loves us unconditionally. This is the basis of a stewardship way of life.

At the end of the Gospel passage, Jesus encourages us to pursue a relationship with the Father: Ask Him, seek Him, knock on His door! Fall into His loving arms!

He can hardly wait to bless us, His children. Remember that this week, then go, be a blessing to others.

Some thoughts from Deacon Jim:

Often, we say the words of the Our Father without thinking of their meaning. I know I do that on occasion. Obviously, we should think about what we are saying. Afterall, we are talking to God. Before you pray the Our Father next time, think about what some of these phrases mean. *Hallowed be thy name*, that is, I recognize that I need to honor your name.

Thy kingdom come, that is, let all that is in me and in the world be in accord with your will. Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who have trespassed against us, that is, help me forgive those who have hurt me, so that I am worthy of your forgiveness. Even if you can't always concentrate on the words of your prayers, don't stop praying, just try harder to think about the words the next time. For all of us, it's good to remember what St. Paul wrote, "Pray without ceasing." (1 Thes 5:17)
