#### **Offertory Gift Bearers**

We will be implementing a new process so that all parishioners to have the opportunity to offer the gifts of Bread & Wine to the presider. A small "disk" will be placed next to the Bread & Wine on the credence table on the left side of the center aisle at the back of the church. Any 2 people, couple, or family wishing to offer the gifts will take the disk as soon as they arrive for Mass, inform the lead greeter, and then hold the disk until they come back to brings the gifts forward. We suggest they sit close to the back. During the collection, the holder of the disk will come to the back, and they will be guided on how to bring the Offertory gifts to the priest.

#### **Archdiocese for Military Services**

Did you know that without the Archdiocese for the Military Services (AMS) there would be no Catholic Chaplains? The AMS is the only Catholic diocese in the United States responsible for endorsing priests to serve as military chaplains and for VA Medical Centers chaplains.

The AMS receives no US Government funding and has no parishes from which to receive support. It relies totally on donations from individuals, foundations, and organizations for its support of all military service men and women and their families around the world. On **December 3–4**, we will place baskets at all exits from the church for you to make a voluntary donation to help support the Archdiocese for Military Service's work.

## **Questions for Faith Sharing Dec. 11 Third Sunday of Advent**

In next Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 11:2-11, Jesus points to signs to show John's disciples who he is. Healing of physical bodies and good news to the poor: prophesied in the words of Isaiah, these signs point toward a new reality, a new era in salvation history. The signs that once marked the end of Israel's long and bitter exile in a foreign land now mark the arrival of God's kingdom in the person of Jesus.
