Questions for Faith Sharing March 19 Fourth Sunday of Lent

In next Sunday's Gospel, John 9:1, 6-9, 13-17, 34-38, Jesus opens the eyes of a man blind from birth. The Pharisees assume that his blindness results from his sin, or from the sin of his parents, a notion that Jesus sternly rejects (John 9:3). When Jesus tells the blind man that he has seen the Son of Man, this is a literal claim and a spiritual one: the blind man now sees Jesus physically with his own eyes, but he also sees the deeper spiritual truth of who Jesus really is. In that sense, it is the Pharisees who are blind, unable to see.

Reflection for families:

• How often do we judge others by their outward appearance instead of what is in their heart? How can we avoid this?
