"Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will reward them for what they have done." (Prv. 19:17) Did you know that two years ago Holy Trinity formed a St. Vincent de Paul Conference to reach out and serve our neighbors



in need? Since we were formed, we have helped over 170 individuals and families to put food on the table, pay rent and utility bills, and repair their cars. All of this is done as a "hand-up", not as a "hand-out". Here is one recent example of a "hand-up" for a neighbor in need: We helped a single mother who works and home schools her three children. Her car's transmission failed, and she needed the car for her work. Paying for the transmission repair meant that she didn't have money for rent. She received a preliminary notice of eviction and came to us requesting assistance to help with her rent. After a home visit, we partnered with Foothills Church to pay her back rent. She is now able to continue to pay her bills going forward.

### Questions for Faith Sharing Aug. 17 Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In next Sunday's Gospel, Luke 12:49-53, Jesus startles his disciples when he declares that he has come not to bring peace but division. He pointed out that his coming would divide households and that they can't be his disciples unless they are willing to let go even of their families. Following Jesus is not easy. Today as in the first century, people who choose to follow Jesus sometimes find themselves at odds with family members who can't understand their choice. As the Gospel points out, living as true followers of Christ is often uncomfortable.

• Even if it makes you uncomfortable, could you share something about your Christian life with a friend or colleague? You could be an authentic witness that another needs to hear.

## What do I treasure by how I live my life?



Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time WIS 18: 6-9; PS 33: 1, 12, 18-19, 20-22; HEB 11: 1-2, 8-19; LK 12:32-48 or LK 12: 35-40

Whether you are just beginning your stewardship journey or have been living a stewardship way of life for years, today's readings invite us to ask ourselves an important question.

The question is this: "What do you treasure?" Of course, we all know the "right" answers: we treasure our faith, our family, and our friendships. Those are all good answers, but Jesus tells us in the Gospel passage from Luke how we can discover the real answer to this question. He says, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

To know what we really treasure, we need to do a check on our hearts. We can ask ourselves questions like: "Where do I spend the majority of my energy? Where do I find my thoughts dwelling? How do I choose to spend my time when I find myself with a few spare moments? What do my spending habits reveal about what is important to me? And here's another one: Where is my mind during Mass?

As Christian stewards, we are called to live our lives in grateful response to all that God has given us. To build and grow a healthy relationship with God. Do I recognize and treasure my relationship with God? Do I treasure the gifts God has given me and share them with others?

### Some thoughts from Deacon Jim:


"What do I treasure? This is a very thought-provoking question. If by "treasure" we mean money or wealth, our focus will be on acquiring more "net worth". If our focus is on power, our "treasure" will be on building our ego or our power base to dominate others (anyone come to mind?). What Jesus is trying to make us realize is that if we want to be with him in eternity, then we need to change our focus and we need to "treasure" his commandment to love and serve our neighbor in the same way that he (Jesus) loves us.

At the Last Supper, he said, "I give you a new commandment. Love one another as I have loved you... By this, everyone will know you are my disciples, if you love one another." (John 13:34-35) What do you treasure in your life? Do you show your love for others as Jesus loves you? If not, how might you change the focus of your life to make it closer to what Jesus taught and to strengthen your relationship with him? Don't try to change overnight. Baby steps work!
